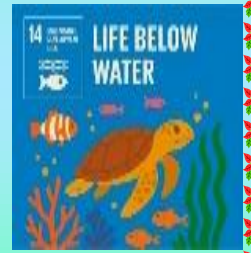

#### 3. Scrapbook Activity

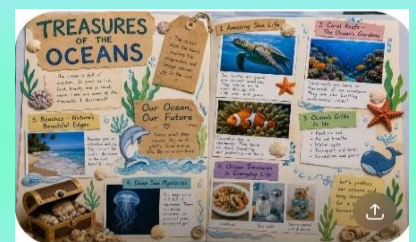
Create a mini scrapbook using newspaper cuttings, pictures of sea animals, facts about oceans. Write captions and short description about each of these pictures.

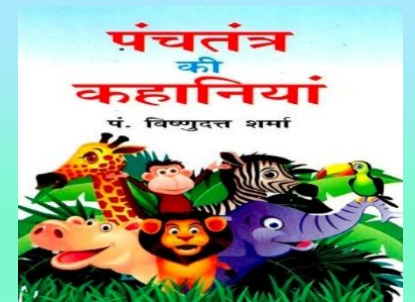

**Sea Animal Count**

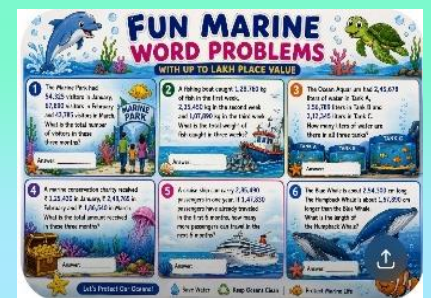

### 3. Create a puppet show on saving oceans

Story-Marine animals like turtle, fish, dolphin, crab become sad because plastic monster is polluting the ocean. A child teaches people to reduce plastic use and clean beaches. The ocean becomes clean again.

Step 2- Make easy puppets using old socks, ice cream sticks, paper plates etc.

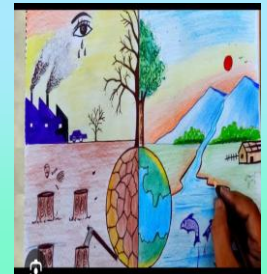
Step 3- Create a puppet stage using cardboard box or curtain using bedsheet, shell, drawing etc.

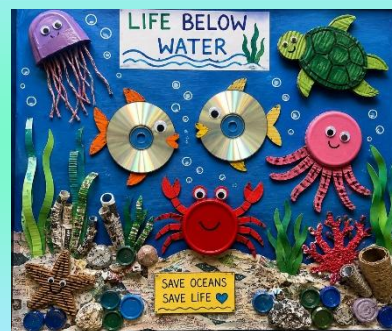
## EK BHARAT SHRESHTHA BHARAT ACTIVITY
